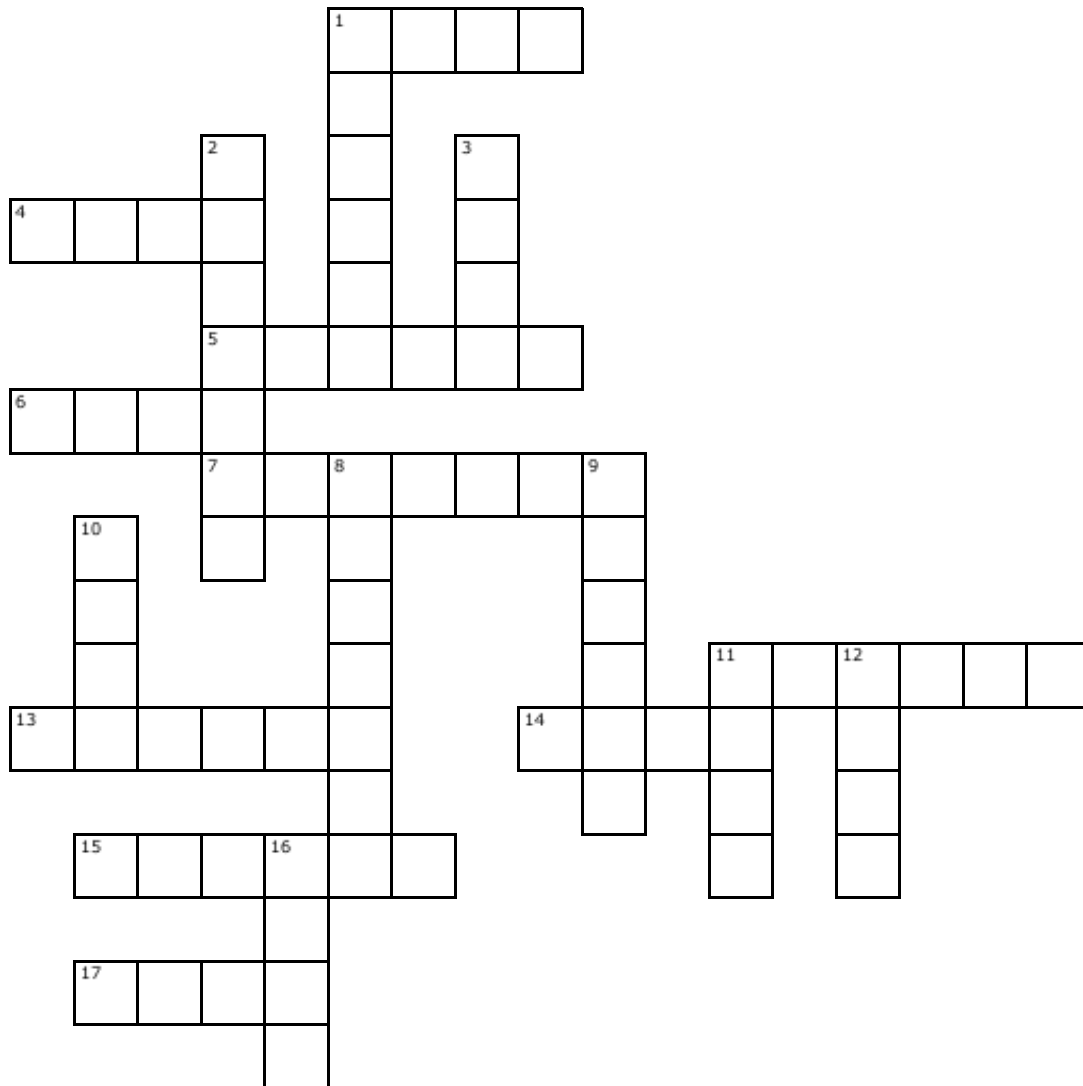


Short Story Vocabulary - Verbs
